This year's instructors will include:

Master Kevin Schoenebeck has been teaching and training in the martial arts for 41 years. He is a Masirib Guro in the Inayan System of Eskrima, a 8th degree Black Belt in Moo Duk Kwon Tae Kwon Do, 4th Dan in Danzan Ryu Ju Jitsu under Shihan Russ Rhodes, and holds a teaching certificate under Sifu David Leung in Tai Chi/Qi Gong.

Master Dennis Dufek started his martial arts training in 1967 with Master James B. C. Yu. He currently holds a 5th degree Black Belt in Hapkido & Ji Do Kwon Tae Kwon Do. He was a police officer for 30 years which gave him many opportunities to use his martial arts. His chief instructor is Doug Menard. Mr. Menard has been training in martial arts for 26 years and teaching with Master Dufek in the Escanaba Michigan area.

Sensei Herb Blue has been involved in Martial arts for over 37 years now. Most of his training was on the West Coast, but he moved to the Green Bay area a few years ago. He is a 3rd Degree Black belt in Modern Arnis, and a 3rd Degree Black belt in Wado Kai and a 2nd degree in Wu Ying Tao. He is former President of the Modern Arnis Northern California Division.

Lahong Guro Jeremy Derenne has been studying Martial arts for 24 years. He is a 4th Degree Black Belt in Tae Kwon do and a 4th Degree Black Belt in Danzan Ryu JuJitsu, under Shihan Russ Rhodes- Advance Guro in Inayan Eskrima under Suro Jason Inay. He also has been training in Wing Chung and Tai Chi under Sifu David Leung from Eugene Oregon.

Master Thomas Swartwood

Has been doing martial arts for 37 years. He is a 7th degree Black Belt in Hapkido. He is also a Master instructor in Mehan Hapkido. He also holds a black belt in Tae Kwon do. He has been teaching defensive tactics for years. In 2005 Mr. Swartwood was inducted in the inaugural class of the Budo hall of Fame as Hapkido instructor of the year.
